



CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR THE VICTORIAN BAR COUNCIL BY-ELECTION

Nominations are hereby called for a by-election to fill a vacancy in the 2018-2019 Bar Council. The by-election will be conducted online. Instructions for online voting are attached.

One candidate is to be elected in the category of Queen's counsel, senior counsel or junior counsel of not less than 15 years' standing.

Standing is calculated as at the time by which nominations for election are to be received by the Secretary, being **5pm, Monday 6 May 2019**.

The poll will open at **9am on Wednesday 8 May 2019** and close at **5pm on Wednesday 15 May 2019**.

The declaration of the poll will take place at 4:45pm on **Thursday 16 May 2019**.

Conditions of eligibility to nominate and to be nominated are prescribed by clauses 11.7, 13.7, 48.1 and 48.2 of the constitution of the Victorian Bar.
