Fruit was picked from a single site (420m) in nearby Charleston during early March 2018. A lifted tropical and lime zest nose leads to a vibrant passionfruit and gooseberry palate with a well-balanced, clean finish. A finely structured Adelaide Hills Sauvignon Blanc with true varietal character.

### **2016 Bass River Chardonnay (Gippsland, Vic)**

From one of the founding grape growers in South Gippsland. A more restrained style that offers a balance of flavours and a fine line of acidity and fruit giving layers and depth. White stone fruit, a dash of citrus with lemon curd, leesy creaminess across the palate.

### **2017 Rob Hall Pinot Noir (Yarra Valley, Vic)**

Rob Hall was the winemaker at Iconic Mount Mary for over 10 years. He is now producing wines under his own label that embody the style, quality and class of a top Yarra Valley producer without the price tag.

“Hand-picked in small batches from multiple vineyards most destemmed, 10% of the batches fermented with 100% whole bunches, matured in French oak (10% new) This shares it’s elegance with Harriet’s vineyard, and also a balanced web of spicy, savoury tannins.
