His Honour Joseph, QC

The President and members of the Victorian Bar extend deepest sympathy to the family of His Honour Joseph O'Shea QC. He qualified by 5 years long Articles; practised briefly as a Solicitor in Myrtleford; then at the Bar more than 19½ years. He had a broad general practice and appeared in all jurisdictions – including before the High Court and the Privy Council in London. He served with distinction as a Judge of the County Court for 30 years – amongst the longest serving Judges in Australia in modern times – and was Acting Chief Judge. He was a member of the Bar more than 68½ years.
