His Honour Judge Kevin Patrick, AM

The President and members of the Victorian Bar extend deepest sympathy to the family of His Honour Judge Kevin O'Connor AM. For the last nearly 30 years, he lived in Sydney. He was a District Court Judge and a Deputy President of NCAT (NSW's VCAT). His school was St Joseph's CBC North Melbourne. He graduated LL B (Hons) from Melbourne, later LL M there and from Illinois. He practised briefly as a solicitor at Stedman Cameron and briefly at the Victorian Bar. He achieved tenure at the Melbourne Law School and made his mark in Law Reform at the ALRC; as Deputy Secretary Policy in the Victorian Law Department; and at the NSWLRC; also as foundation Australian Privacy Commissioner. He was foundation President of the NSW Administrative Decisions Tribunal, an NCAT predecessor, for some 16 years before becoming an NCAT Deputy President.
